Assessment specifications:

The learner will safely undertake maintenance of concrete pumping machinery and equipment to the standard of a commercially competent Concrete Pump Operator.

Maintenance includes post pumping operation procedures and preventative maintenance practices.

Concrete pumping equipment and machinery checks include pump and truck, whip check, reducers, clamps, seals, clips, safety pins, hoses and pipeline.

Performance must reflect industry best practice.

- Safety practices during clean out and maintenance
- Machinery and equipment compliance check requirements pipe thickness testing, hose & reducer testing, visual fatigue checks of pump machinery and delivery system equipment
- Manufacturer's maintenance guidelines and instructions
- Post pumping operation clean out procedures, safety and environmental considerations.
- Visual inspection of concrete pump machinery and equipment prior to leaving site
- Daily checks: basic lubrication, check hydraulics for leakages, waterbox monitoring and preventative maintenance
- Compliance checking schedules.
