- Motivation for safe practices.

Personal wellbeing

- Fatigue.
- Long hours.
- Stress management.
- Wellbeing strategies.
- Awareness of others onsite.

Adaptive and situational safety

- Input into day-to-day practices.
- Common hazards in the construction environment, including site hazards.
- Underground services.
- Tools – 5x5 and 7-point analysis.
- Complex safety systems.
- Continuous safety improvements.
