Assessment specifications:

To achieve this standard ākonga must be capable of identifying when musculoskeletal harm can occur and apply appropriate protective techniques during a rigging operation.

Evidence is required during set up, undertaking a rigging activity, and during the dismantling and storage of rigging equipment.

Competence requires ākonga to be capable of:

- repeating the protective technique on demand.
- in different and unfamiliar contexts.
