




Introducing Verian

10 minute online survey.




32 providers from the education sector.



Verian provided the survey link and Waihanga Ara Rau managed the invitations and reminders.











Awareness and knowledge of Waihanga Ara Rau are relatively high among providers.




How much do you know about Waihanga Ara Rau ... in terms of what it is and what it does?





Source: SP5 - And overall, how satisfied are you with the engagement with...




Waihanga Ara Rau has a positive nett promoter score among providers. Nearly half of providers say they are highly likely to recommend Waihanga Ara Rau to others in the construction and infrastructure sector.

Most stakeholders find the Waihanga Ara Rau Assurance team to be very collaborative.







Half of providers say they engage with Waihanga Ara Rau at least monthly. A further third engage quarterly.


Engagement with Waihanga Ara Rau


Half of providers engage about post-assessment moderation. Forty-two percent engage around the review or development of standards, qualifications, and/or micro-credentials. Between a third and a quarter engage about post-assessment moderation, micro-credential support, and programme endorsement.

Providers who engage about each of these areas are generally very satisfied.



Seventy percent of providers believe qualifications, standards and micro-credentials are relevant, match the skills learners need and are easy to understand. Sixty five percent feel being involved with the Qualifications team has been valuable to their origination, and fifty five percent say it was clear what their organisation's role was and believe they have seen improvements in their assurance practices as a result of their engagements with the Assurance team.





Around two thirds of providers agree Waihanga Ara Rau has a clear vision and strategy and is trustworthy. Measures around leadership and adaptability are not quite as strong.





Most providers agree Waihanga Ara Rau understands sector workforce needs, is helping to raise the capability of the future workforce, contributes to improvements in education, qualifications and training in New Zealand, and takes appropriate action in response to feedback from insights and industry.



More than two thirds of providers agree Waihanga Ara Rau is simple and effortless to deal with and keeps providers well informed. Measures around targeted communications to, understanding of, and support for, specific organisations are slightly weaker.



Measures around Waihanga Ara Rau advocating for, and contributing to, industry improvements for minority groups also sit slightly lower. However, this is largely due to many providers saying they 'don't know' as opposed to feelings of dissatisfaction.



When it comes to workforce development in New Zealand, between half and two thirds of providers agree industry feedback is evident in development plans and qualifications, qualifications and standards reflect the skills industry needs, and nationally, the consistency and quality of training is improving.



Three quarters of providers say they support the skills workforce strategy. Two thirds say they are confident that training is improving. Half feel confident that sector priorities are well understood and that graduates in and entering construction have the relevant skills.
